

CODE OF ETHICAL COMMITTEE

1. The Institutional Ethics Committee, Institute of Dental Sciences Sehora, Jammu (IEC-IDS-JAMMU) is laid on the principles of World Declaration Helsinki-Ethical Principles for Medical Research involving human subjects 2013 and it expects the researchers to follow the guidelines proposed by the same.
2. For the compliance of the same, the Conflict of interest and letter of confidentiality should be duly signed by all Ethics committee members and maintained for the record purposes.
3. It is mandatory for all the researchers to submit all clinical trials studies to Indian safety drug data or literature.
4. In case of animal studies, approval mentioning about the same should be obtained under Animal Ethical Committee which is a branch of institute ethical committee.
5. As per the guidelines of Ethical Committee, detail information sheet and consent form in English and vernacular language is made compulsory for faculty and students before taking patient as a subject for research.
6. Meetings are conducted on first Friday every 3 months or as an emergency meeting on monday following submission of any research proposal for approval of project and also for compliance of previous proposed projects.

4. To ensure principles of non-exploitation, privacy and confidentiality. Principles of precaution and risk minimisation, professional competency, accountability and transparency.
5. To ensure principles of responsibility public domain and compliance are observed.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (3) of rule 17 of the Chapter-4 of the New Drugs and Clinical Trials rules, 2019, and the National Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical and Health Research Involving Human Participants, specified by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) o Rules and regulations are followed according to the office of Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, Department of Health Research, 2'd floor, IRCS Building, New Delhi 110001.
3. Approval of the research project is in accordance to the format suggested by DHR, which includes an undertaking by the investigator to follow all the rules and regulations. The IEC approves the project by giving reviewers comments in the form of an approval letter signed by the Member Secretary.
4. For the compliance of the same, the Conflict of interest and letter of confidentiality should be duly signed by all Ethics committee members and maintained for the record purposes.
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
